Logista Integrates Its Fleet with Low-Impact Refrigerated Semi-Trailers

Thanks to Thermo King® AxlePower technology, Logista reduces CO₂ emissions and improves fleet efficiency.

Logista, Europe's leading distributor of products and services for retail points, has received its first refrigerated semi-trailer equipped with Thermo King®'s AxlePower dynamic energy recovery system. Thermo King, a brand of Trane Technologies, is a leader in transport temperature control solutions. This initiative aims to reduce CO₂ emissions and enhance the efficiency of the company's refrigerated semi-trailer fleet, aligning with its ESG goals.

Thermo King AxlePower enables electric cooling with self-charging during transit. It is a fully integrated system, independent of the tractor unit, combining BPW's ePower axle with Thermo King's ENERG-e battery pack and smart energy management technology.

The Thermo King Advancer refrigeration unit operates in silent mode with zero CO_2 emissions when running on battery power, allowing for sustainable transport over long distances, as well as in Ultra Low Emission Zones (ULEZs) and areas with noise restrictions. On average, an AxlePower system can reduce CO_2 emissions by 7.5 tons per year compared to a diesel-powered transport refrigeration unit (TRU), with reductions reaching up to 12 tons annually for semi-trailers operating around 3,000 hours per year.

The Thermo King AxlePower system uses intelligent self-generated energy management, dynamically monitoring road conditions and driving operations to maximize the recovery of kinetic and thermal energy through the semi-trailer's electric axle. Fleet managers can monitor battery charge status and vehicle performance in real time, ensuring efficiency without requiring driver intervention. Unlike other axle generators, AxlePower's sophisticated control system deactivates the electric axle during uphill climbs, preventing unnecessary fuel consumption, increasing operational efficiency, and reducing both operating costs and emissions.

Logista has already achieved an 84% rate of kilometers traveled using low-impact vehicles and aims to reach 90% by 2026, in line with its ESG commitments.

Pedro de Bernardo, Managing Director for Iberia and Poland at Logista, stated: "With this integration into our fleet, we continue to innovate to offer increasingly sustainable services and reduce the carbon footprint of our transport division. To achieve this, we adopt technologies that support our decarbonization goals while also improving energy and operational efficiency."
