Open Day at Logista Cash&Carry in Settala (Milan)

The company continues to invest in its widespread presence across the territory with a renewed facility designed for the responsible use of energy resources

Settala, 16 April 2026

Logista, Europe's leading distributor of products and services for points of sale, is hosting a special Open Day tomorrow, 17 April 2026, starting at 9:00 a.m. at its Cash & Carry in Settala. The facility is designed to serve retailers throughout Lombardy. Each year it handles 30,000 deliveries, for a total of 90,000 packages, supported by 14 field agents active in the region.

Through the renewed Cash & Carry, Logista Retail ensures the distribution of a wide selection of convenience items such as food & beverage, stationery, games, personal care products, batteries and, more generally, products dedicated to the Bar-Tobacconists channel. The company confirms its role as an ideal partner for commercial activities thanks to a complete assortment of leading brands, customized delivery and payment services tailored to the needs of retailers.

Located in Caleppio di Settala (MI), at [via Achille Grandi 12](#) (tel. 02 9509 6280), the Cash & Carry covers a total area of 3,200 sqm, divided into commercial space, offices and warehouse. The logistics hub also hosts Logista's Transit Point dedicated to the distribution of tobacco and inhalation products to retailers across Lombardy. The depot serves over 2,500 points of sale, carries out 180,000 deliveries per year, manages 23 daily routes, and its fleet travels 700,000 km annually.

The renovation of company sites is a tangible expression of Logista's extensive presence across Italy. Through targeted investments and specialized solutions for different sectors, the company enables increasingly fast and sustainable market access for all stakeholders, generating benefits for the entire supply chain.

Settala Cash & Carry stands out for its responsible and efficient use of energy resources. In addition to a photovoltaic system and an electric charging station serving two parking spaces, the facility has recently replaced traditional industrial lighting with LED lamps. Logista has adopted since long time a sustainability-oriented strategy across all its operations: from the use of renewable energy sources in 99% of its operational sites, to the reuse and recycling of Logista Green Box, the cardboard boxes used daily for goods distribution, up to the program for collecting spent electronic cigarettes in dedicated containers placed in tobacconists, with no purchase obligation. In Lombardy this network includes over 1,400 collection points. The initiative has seen a wide national participation, involving over 60% of tobacconists, confirming the company's commitment to increasingly sustainable consumption models.

Giampaolo Montesano, Distribution & Transport Director at Logista Italia, states: *"This site represents the increasingly strong relationship with our commercial partners, particularly more than 2,500 retailers who can satisfy their needs promptly here, with positive effects on their business, the distribution system and tax revenues. Moreover, the Settala Cash & Carry fully reflects Logista's evolution in terms of diversification and sustainability: from the use of reusable and recyclable Logista Green Box to the network for collecting spent electronic cigarettes, which allows them to be sent to treatment and recycling facilities."*
